

The River Management Plan (RMP) for the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River calls for local governments to play an important role in the management of the river corridor.

The Upper Delaware Council (UDC) recognizes that financial support is critical for its member towns and townships to institute effective programs. The U.S. Department of the Interior provides annual funding to the UDC through its Cooperative Agreement with the National Park Service to enable a Technical Assistance Grant (TAG) program.

In FY 2008, \$30,000 has been budgeted.

UDC grants have been awarded for planning, preparation, or printing of zoning ordinances, laws, and other regulations. TAGs have also helped fund publications and educational programs, including maps, pamphlets, and training workshops. See the directory on the reverse side for a complete list.

Preliminary TAG funding in 1988 subsidized four start-up projects completed by UDC consultants Hoffman, Williams, Lafen and Fletcher: Design Handbook development, \$21,100; Visitor Information Map & Guide brochure, \$10,228; Hazardous Materials Risk Assessment, \$7,224; and Local Government Directory, \$2,968.

The deadline for the 2008 TAG program is July 31. The UDC's Project Review Committee will meet with applicants on Aug. 12 and make funding recommendations to the UDC.

UDC Technical Assistance Grants may be awarded for these general uses:

- To prepare or upgrade a municipality's zoning ordinance or other relevant law, plan, or ordinance in keeping with the River Management Plan.
- To publish such an ordinance.
- To address a problem or specific project identified in the River Management Plan.
- To prepare educational materials, maps, brochures, and guides that assist in the implementation of the River Management Plan.

Note: Grant recipients may rely on in-house personnel, outside subcontractors, or non-profit organizations to complete their projects.

UDC Technical Assistance Grants have the following criteria:

- Grant terms are for one year. Quarterly reports are required. Upon evaluation of work progress, a maximum of two 6-month extensions may be allowed.
- The UDC member town or township (or its respective county) must be the applicant submitting the application, even if a partnering subcontractor will actually perform the tasks.
- Funding is not available for "bricks and mortar" capital improvement construction projects.
- All projects must be related to the implementation of the River Management Plan.
- The member town or township must enter into a contract with the UDC as grant administrator.
- Grant funds will be disbursed only upon completion of the full project and submission of a request for payment documenting the project expenses.

The Upper Delaware Council has awarded a total of \$609,692 from FY 1988-2007 for 173 projects related to the implementation of the River Management Plan for the Upper Delaware Scenic and Recreational River.
